Honorary SDWT member Mike Mahoney is a full time production woodturner specializing in utility wares, nested bowls and hollow forms. Mike's work is in many of the finest turning collections in the world. His work has been accepted into many of the top juried craft shows in the USA. Mike has demonstrated internationally in seven different countries and has produced several instructional videos and a signature line of finishes.

I have been a production salad bowl maker for 20 years. I produce utilitarian bowls geared towards American Crafts Galleries. I also produce one of a kind urns,

nested bowl sets, canisters, and hollow forms. Over my years as a production turner have made me aware of the importance of repetition to perfect a skill. I feel I can translate this skill to my students to make them more skillful and productive.

Mike will be demonstrating and turning three projects: plate, bowl, and pepper grinder.

Torrey Pines Gift Shop: The TP Gift Shop continues to be a successful outlet and revenue generator for TAV. In December we placed the (22) “Bandsaw Trees” that Karen Freitas made for the potluck center-pieces (thank you Karen) and a new prospective product of (8) mushrooms turned from small branches of Torrey Pine. Hopefully the park visitors find these items enjoyable enough to purchase.

Equipment Inventory: The lathe and machinery inventory has been completed and documented at each TAV site. Lathes are clearly marked by serial number and a simple identifier to facilitate future machine inventory counts.

While cleaning out the Fallbrook storage unit, there was a great purge of items old, unused and of questionable value. This includes various kits, stoppers, seam rippers, keychains and the like. The “go-forward” focus for the near term with TAV is PENS! That inventory is much easier to manage and the product has broad appeal across all demographics.
