Our days are typically on a select Saturday of the Month. 8:30 am to 12:00 pm



Turn Around for Vets (TAV) is a critical program of the San Diego Woodturners Club. All TAV activities are carried out by a dedicated, unpaid group of volunteers so that 100% of donated funds, designated for TAV, are used to purchase supplies and equipment and to support the program.

September was a relatively quiet month for TAV. All three sites were busy but it was the last month of summer so we were not super busy.

On September 22, Fred Thompson and I attended a Celebration of Life for Ross Mandryk at the mobile home park where he and his son Rory live. We were able to meet about 30 of their neighbors, friends and family. On one of my trips to get donations for TAV, Rory and I found a partially completed small plaque with the Marine Corps emblem engraved. Rory is a Marine veteran. I told Rory I would complete it and return to him. I presented it to him during the celebration and he was very appreciative. I was asked by Ross' grandson Josh to tell people about the TAV program so they could have a better idea of what he did with us. Many people told me they had pens, clocks and other turned items that Ross had made for them. Fred and I also heard stories about how he supported his community when he was not working with TAV. Overall it was a very enjoyable low key gathering to honor our very special friend.

Richard Winkler, one of our volunteer instructors at Navy Medical Center has started taking pictures of "pen of the day" to recognize and encourage participants. We don't always have an outstanding project but the participants enjoy critiquing each others efforts. In preparation for the pen making demo at our October meeting, I hope these acrylic pens help to peak club members' interest.







Turn Around for Veterans (TAV) con't

I will have special pen kits and blanks, donated by Ross Mandryk, available before and after the October meeting.

SDWT has been invited to set up a booth at the **German American Society (GAS) Weinacht-market (German Christmas Market) in El Cajon on 9 and 10 December.** I have talked with Steve Frick regarding being the event coordinator. This is another good opportunity to interact with the public promoting SDWT and TAV. I have met with the coordinator and some other members of GAS in El Cajon. This is the first year they are doing this German Christmas market. They have set aside an area where we can set up our booth with 3 lathes and a donations table, similar to the Vista Strawberry Festival. We are directly in front of a storage room where we can store our equipment and inventory overnight. They have been sponsoring the El Cajon Octoberfest for many years so they have experience with these types of events. They are anticipating about 1,000 visitors over the 2 days.

Set up on Saturday December 9 will be from 0930 to 1130 and the event will be open to the public from 2pm to 8pm. On Sunday the event will be open from 2pm to 7pm and the booth will need to be removed by 11pm.

I will bring a signup sheet for volunteers to work at the booth. First shift on Saturday the 9th would include booth set up. The afternoon shift would need to move our stuff into the storage room for the night. Sunday morning would reset the booth and the afternoon shift would need to pack everything up.

TAV continues to need new volunteers, especially at NMC. I encourage all members to consider volunteering even if you can only make one day per month.

I will be making another trip to the Torrey Pines Gift Shop before the holiday season gets into full swing. If you have turned items to donate to TAV, whether they are Torrey Pine or any other wood, please bring them to me at the October meeting.




