This Months guest demonstrator is **Doug Schneiter**. Growing up on a farm in Eastern Iowa, Doug has always been surrounded by trees and wood. Earning a B.A. from the University of Northern Iowa and an M.S. from Colorado State in Industrial Technology Education led to nearly 30 years of teaching woodworking to students of all ages. He has given woodturning workshops throughout the Western U.S. and has demonstrated at several Woodturning Symposiums. His focus on artistic wood turning began in the early 1990's, after being challenged and inspired by some wood turning legends. Through wood turning I have met some incredible people, and have shared some very memorable experiences.

Doug demonstrated at SDWT in March 2019 and returns to share again his technique and process towards turning and preparing a piece to reflect a "Basket Illusion". The illusion embellishment and decorative process can be applied not only on plates and bowls but also on boxes, tool handles and even applied to embellishment of a turned bottle stopper.

This is an opportunity to up your turning and artistic skills and turn a piece with this embellish technique to stand out among just common turned wooden bowls. 

Mentoring Program


