

#### **SHAVINGS**

from the Prez . . .

**Wow, June!** The year is almost half over already! More than 50 % of San Diegans are vaccinated, COVID-19 infection rates are declining, things are opening up and the future is looking brighter. It is time for SDWT to work on a re-opening plan!

#### SDWT Re-Opening:

During the pandemic virtual demonstrators were in high demand and very hard to find. Our Program Director, Sally Ault, has done a wonderful job in arranging high quality presenters for our virtual Zoom meetings. Currently virtual demonstrations are scheduled through October. Our first live demo at Nottingham Center is scheduled for November and will feature our own Sally Ault and Karen Freitas. In December, we are planning on an in-person Holiday Party. Our A/V

Zoom Committee has been hard at work identifying significant upgrades to our existing A/V system. New cameras, switches, microphones and other items have been ordered and will soon be installed. Following installation, extensive training in the use of this equipment will begin. A significant problem at the Nottingham Center is the lack of a high speed internet connection to support live streaming. The A/V Zoom Committee is exploring ways to live stream from Nottingham. <u>If an adequate internet connection can be achieved at Nottingham before November, the club meetings will be held in-person and we will live stream our already scheduled remote demonstrators on our big screen TVs.</u>

We will be having *in-person* "Wood Days, Etc." at Nottingham Center in July and September. Wood Day, etc. will be held at Nottingham Center on Saturday, July 10, from 09:00 until 12:00.

TAV is beginning to re-open. SDWT volunteers resumed TAV at the VA Aspire Center in Old Town on Wednesday, May 19, and will continue every Wednesday. The Aspire Center is an inpatient treatment center and all staff and patients are vaccinated. We work outside on a balcony. The set-up has been modified to produce adequate spacing to maintain social distancing. This results in a decrease of lathes available for turning from 7 to 5, but things are running smoothly. The Armed Services YMCA working with the Naval Medical Center San Diego (Balboa) has begun to process volunteer credentialling and several of us have completed ours and are ready to go. It is still uncertain when we will be able to re-open at the Naval Hospital, but we are hoping sometime this summer. Paul Simpson, TAV Director, is in discussion with the officials at Camp Pendleton on a reopening plan for TAV at the Wounded Warrior battalion.

We are working to re-start <u>Drop-In Tuesdays</u>. Roman Scheidel has graciously volunteered to be the interim leader. I would like others to volunteer to help with the effort. Drop in Tuesdays will begin on Tuesday, June 15, from 3:00 PM – 7:00 PM. Lathes will be set up outside with appropriate spacing. There are a maximum of 8 lathes and use of the lathes will be on a first come basis. Safety rules will be enforced. Eye protection, dust masks and social distancing are required. Participants must be members of SDWT in good standing and must agree to follow safety practices as presented by instructors. Please contact Roman Scheidel if you would like to volunteer to help or are interested in participating. The second session will be on Tuesday, June 29, and we hope every week thereafter. Please look for emails from San Diego Woodturners (info@sdwt.org) for further details.

#### **Extra Virtual Demonstrations:**

From time to time we have and will offer more than one demo in a month. Your Program Director, Sally Ault, has worked diligently to provide us with excellent varied content and skilled demonstrators at both our regular meetings and the extra demos. On Saturday, May 29, Cindy Drozda presented one of the finest demonstrations that I have ever seen. Cindy is a master finial maker and her topic was Fabulous Finials. Her Zoom set-up is first rate and she focused on design, proper tool presentation and basic skills. Unfortunately, only 52 joined her presentation.

Our next bonus presentation is with the Channel Island Woodturners on Saturday, June 12, at 09:30. Glenn Lucas from Ireland will demonstrate the making of a lidded box. Glenn Lucas is one of the finest wood turners in the world, has a first rate Zoom set-up and is an excellent demonstrator

Many of the top tier demonstrators do not permit their sessions to be recorded, so please plan to attend in person.

#### A/V Zoom Committee:

The A/V Zoom Committee, under the leadership of Andy Boyer, developed an A/V Zoom plan that was approved by the Board. The recommended equipment was ordered and has been received. Planning for installation of the equipment at Nottingham Center will occur during Wood Day, etc. on July 10. Following installation the equipment will be tested and operators trained. We are still awaiting a high speed internet connection later this year.

#### **AAW Virtual Symposium:**

The AAW Virtual Symposium will be held July 17 - 18, 2021. Registration is now open. The fee is only \$45.00. This promises to be an excellent symposium. Registrants will receive access to recordings of the symposium for a month after the symposium. I hope that you will register and attend.

Recent SDWT By Laws Change to Membership Categories provided below for your info and will be officially included in our By Laws within the Members Only area of our Website. By Laws change is hereby provided for your information:

#### **SDWT Membership Categories:**

There are currently five membership categories: Regular Membership, Life Membership, Honorary Membership, TAV Sponsored Membership and Student Membership. Because the criteria for these membership categories were incomplete or unclear, the Board reviewed and defined each category.

The SDWT Board of Directors sets the membership dues for each membership category.

**Regular Members**: Regular members pay dues on a calendar year basis. They receive a membership card, the password to the Members Only Section of the SDWT website and links to club virtual meetings. Paid regular members are eligible to take classes, utilize our mentors, volunteer for TAV and other club activities and receive the member rate for paid club meetings.

<u>Life Members</u>: This membership category will be discontinued. All current Life Members will be "grandfathered" and will continue as life members. The existing Life Members do not pay dues. They receive membership cards, the password to the Members Only section of the SDWT website and links to club virtual meetings. Life Members are eligible to take classes, utilize our mentors, volunteer for TAV and other club activities and receive the member rate for paid club meetings.

<u>Honorary Members</u>: Honorary membership is conferred by the Board of Directors to recognize:

Individuals who are not wood turners but have shown prolonged and exemplary service to our club.

Club members who have moved out of the area in recognition of prolonged and exemplary service to the club and who wish to remain connected to the club. If an Honorary Member moves back to the San Diego area, they will revert to regular membership.

Honorary members do not pay dues. They receive membership cards, the password to the Members Only section of the SDWT website and links to club virtual meetings. Honorary Members are eligible to take classes, utilize our mentors, volunteer for TAV and other club activities and receive the member rate for paid club meetings.

<u>TAV Sponsored Members:</u> TAV participants, approved by the TAV Chairperson, may join the club and have their annual dues paid to the club from the TAV Fund. TAV sponsored members receive a membership card, the password to the Members Only Section of the SDWT website and links to club virtual meetings. TAV members are eligible to take classes, utilize our mentors, volunteer for TAV and other club activities. Upon approval of the TAV Chairperson, the TAV fund pays the member rate for paid club meetings on behalf of the TAV sponsored member.

Student Member: A student member is a full-time student under the age of 25 years who is interested in wood turning. Students under 18 years of age must have a responsible adult (parent) sponsor who will receive emails from the club and be responsible for the behavior of of the student. To maintain student status a student member must attend a minimum of 4 in-person or virtual meetings a calendar year. Students between the ages of 18 and 25 must show documentation of full-time student status. Student members between the ages of 18 and 25 years may volunteer for TAV and other club activities. Students below the age of 18 may <u>not</u> volunteer for TAV, but may volunteer for other club activities with parent written permission. Student members do not pay dues. They receive membership cards. For student members less than 18 years of age the password to the Members Only section of the SDWT website and links to club virtual meetings will be sent to parent emails. Student Members are eligible to take classes (under 18 with written parental permission) and receive the member rate for paid club meetings. Student members may utilize mentors with written parental permission and with a parent in attendance at the mentoring session.

#### **Lastly**

#### **Volunteers Needed:**

As we reopen after being largely shutdown by the pandemic we need people to step-up and volunteer. We need volunteers for TAV (please contact Paul Simpson). Our club is like most clubs in that about 20% of our members do over 90% of the work. This is very unfortunate as volunteering has many rewards for the volunteer. Not only does one feel good after volunteering, volunteers learn new skills and gain unexpected rewards from their efforts. #### Reminder to All SDWT Members



Beginning in 2018, cybercriminals attacked SDWT club officers by using information obtained from our website. Since we have removed contact information from the public areas of our website and increased fraud awareness, these attacks have subsided. However, these criminals are sophisticated and change their tactics frequently.

In addition to direct attacks against our club, new scams are being reported involving tax filing delays, tax refunds, Social Security, the Census, COVID-19 Economic Impact Checks, and COVID-19. These scams involve phishing emails, robocalls and even people coming to our homes to sell non-existent vaccinations, medicines and tests. Be vigilant! Maintain a high level of suspicion!

DO NOT RESPOND TO ROBOCALLS OR CLICK LINKS THAT YOU DO NOT RECOGNIZE!

We must all have a high level of suspicion concerning any request for money, gift cards, banking information, credit card information, PayPal information, crypto currency, etc. and always keep our guard up!

#### SDWT will NEVER:

Send an email asking anyone to send or email gift cards or cryptocurrency.

Send an email asking for money or payment, **EXCEPT** for a class that you have signed up for, and then only send a check for the fee to the treasure at our club's address. SDWT will never ask for gift cards or cryptocurrency to pay for classes.

PayPal is used for membership, and for donations.

**REMEMBER**, cyber criminals are very sophisticated and even the experts can be fooled!

If in doubt, ALWAYS call the treasurer, president or a club officer using the contact information found in the Members Only section of the SDWT website!

# Hollow-Pro Tools

Designed by professional woodturner **Mike Jackofsky** and manufactured in the USA by the *Hunter Tool Company*.

#### 1) The Hollow-Pro Rocket Tool:

These tools feature a unique negative angle built into the tip. They have been specifically designed to use the Hunter carbide cutters; the negative angle makes the carbide less aggressive and easier to control. Hollow Pro Rocket tools are professional, fast and efficient hollowing tools for making hollow vessels up to about 7" high x about 7" diameter. These 8" tools have 3/8" shafts to allow hollowing through very small restricted openings. The tools use replaceable #1 size carbide cutters and are designed to fit into any large handle with a 3/8" or ½" opening. (Tip: place the screws from these handles on the side or top of the tools, so the bottom will slide smoothly on the tool rest).

The round shafts of these tools can be rotated slightly to make clean "shear" cuts and the bent tool is also very useful for undercutting the opening on larger hollow vessels. The kit comes with one straight and one bent tool and includes replaceable Hunter #1 carbide cutters for clean cuts and durability, and a Torx wrench for rotating and replacing the cutters as needed.







2) The Hollow Pro Calipers provide accurate measurements in crucial areas of hollow vessels and open bowls.

Hollow-Pro Calipers are precision made from steel and aluminum for maximum strength while maintain a comfortable light weight. The small size will work for hollow forms up to about 8" in diameter and up to  $6\frac{1}{4}$ " deep. The larger size works for hollow forms up to about 18" in diameter and up to  $11\frac{3}{4}$ " deep.


