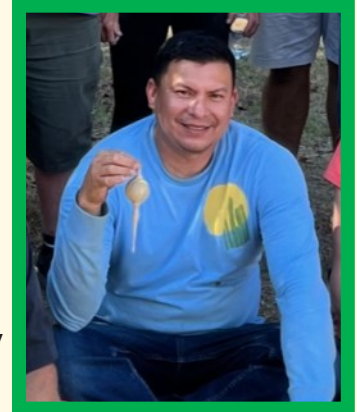

## Turn Around for Veterans (TAV)



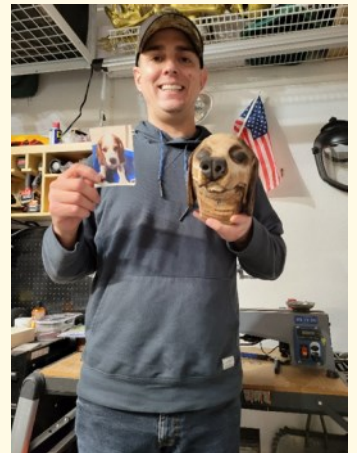

**Design integrity** – proportions, intended use, etc.

**Use of form and color** – eye appeal, etc.
